Lines, Rays, and Line Segments

A line is a straight path that continues on forever in two directions.


A ray is a straight path that continues on forever in one direction.

A line segment is part of a line that has two endpoints.

Identify the lines, the rays, the line segments in the following picture.






Lines: a and e

Rays: c and d

Line Segments: b

Example 2

How many line segments are in the following figure?





A line segment is part of a line that has two endpoints and it has to be a straight line. So there are 4 of them as shown below.
